***Dressage Suitability** is a rail class where horses will be judged at the same time. Horses to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on the horse's potential to become a Dressage mount. Horses are placed and no actual scores are awarded.

****Dressage Equitation** is a rail class where riders will be judged at the same time. Horses will perform the medium walk, working trot, and canter both ways of the ring. The rider's position, seat and specifically the correct use and effect of the aids required by the Training and First Level Dressage tests are to be judged. The movements shall be performed by the exhibitors simultaneously. Only the rider is judged, however, lameness of horses will be penalized.

^New to Dressage is a class for riders that are currently in the first year of showing Dressage. The horse can have previous dressage experience.

Prix Caprilli is a dressage class (with jumps), and dressage or hunter attire is appropriate for these classes.

^^Western/English Versatility Class is a rail class where the same rider/horse pair will first show Western (walk, jog, and lope both directions of the ring) and then change tack in the ring to English Pleasure (walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring). Rider may have up to 3 grooms come in to help change tack in the center of the ring when so directed. Snaffle bits are allowed in the Western section, regardless of horse's age. Any style of English riding is allowed in the English section (dressage seat, hunt seat, or saddle seat).

++Anything goes means exactly that! Dress up in costume, act goofy, practice your stand-up comedy routine, put your grandmother's best friend on your horse for the Lead Line class (or maybe her dog...) .. you can even show a moose that you captured in Rocky Mountain National Park in the Show Dog class (just don't complain to us when you get arrested for moose-napping!).
